Reg and his wife, Rosemary O'Connor, are the Davidsbündler Duo and as such have recorded a CD of works for viola and piano and given concerts in many parts of British Columbia. He and his sister, Angela Goddard, founded and co-direct the Quiring Chamber Music Camp for young musicians, now in its sixteenth year. Reg has served on the music faculty at UBC and the Vancouver Academy of Music, and currently teaches at the Quiring Chamber Music School in Coquitlam.

Rosemary O'Connor, Pianist - Rosemary performs with various chamber ensembles, including the Quiring Chamber Players and Davidsbündler Duo, with her husband, Reg Quiring. She has also been invited to collaborate with Pro Nova Ensemble, Trio Accord, Standing Wave Ensemble, and Simon Fraser University's Contemporary Chamber Players. Rosemary co-produces and performs in Evergreen Cultural Centre's Chamber Music Series as a member of the Quiring Chamber Players, along with guest artists such as Ian Swensen, Anita Krause, Dale Barltrop, Andrew Dawes, Catherine French, and members of the St. Lawrence String Quartet and Vancouver Symphony.

Rosemary has performed solo and chamber music concerts in the USA, Canada, Germany, Lithuania, Belgium and Portugal and Italy. She currently teaches at the Quiring Chamber Music School in Coquitlam
